Dear Mr. Hulsman,

The visiting students and professors of the University of Vienna wish to thank you and the *Center for Intercultural Dialogue and Translation* again for your excellent work in arranging a most interesting program for study during our visit to Egypt. Our purpose was to better understand Egyptian contemporary religious and political culture, in particular the place of Christians in a predominantly Muslim society, which you succeeded well in doing. The meetings with leaders and scholars from the Orthodox, Catholic and Protestant Churches, al-Azhar, the Dar al-Iftah and also with representatives from different political streams in Egypt, Liberal, Muslim Brothers and Salafis were most enlightening.
